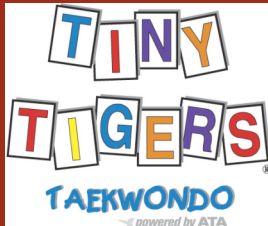


American Taekwondo Association®

Tiny Tigers & Karate for Kids



Tiny Tigers

The Tiny Tigers program, developed by the American Taekwondo Association, was specially designed to help our youngest students become accustomed to an organized classroom environment. "Tiny Tigers" learn how to follow directions, and work in a group while having FUN. The program also works to develop motor skills, hand eye coordination, and balance. All skills they learn while learning to "kick and punch."

Perhaps the most important aspect of the Tiny Tiger program is the life skills taught as part of class. We reinforce many of the life lessons parents teach their kids daily. Lessons like courtesy, discipline, respect, and confidence. Come join our tigers and watch them have so much fun they don't even know they're learning.

Karate for Kids

Our Karate for Kids program is for kids and teens 7-13 years old. We teach the same information as in our tigers program just in a more traditional fashion. The program puts a larger emphasis on proper technique while not minimizing the importance of courtesy, discipline and confidence.

Daycare program features

Our instructors

All the instructors teaching in your Tiny Tigers Programs, whether in a daycare or in our main facility, are specially trained working with young children. Each instructor coming to your facility has had a minimum of 200 hours instruction training and been tested on their knowledge and ability to teach small children. All instructors have been background checked by ATA headquarters as part of their certification. They are really fun too. Ask them about bug races and fireball.

We take care of everything!

The Karate for Kids daycare programs have the unique feature of being able to not only implement their programs in your available space they will bring with them all the needed equipment to teach. This means that when class ends there are no pads, mats, sparring gear or uniforms left in your facility. We will bring with us on each visit all the items your students need to go to class, including their uniforms.

Student Promotion

Students in our daycare programs learn the same material students in our main facility, they simply progress at a slower pace. We do hold rank testings for our daycare students quarterly. These testings normally take place at the facility nearest to your center. Testing fees are separate and will be explained to parents and students as they begin the program.

Student Transfers

Many of the students in our daycare program have so much fun they look for additional training. Students who transfer to our full time programs are still allowed to train in the daycare center. Financial agreements with the daycare center remain in effect when a student transfers to the full time program until that student is no longer enrolled at that daycare center.

Added Revenue

As a partner with our daycare centers we will make a financial arrangement that compensates the center for their facility and access to their students. Terms are finalized upon agreement with facility.
